Bohler® / Martin Miller® Shallow Profile is a 14-tooth and HP-44 edge-hard rule with a unique gullet profile that requires minimal penetration on various substrates. While this rule cuts many materials with little impression, a uniform and leveled anvil is strongly recommended. This is also a good option for soft anvil roller diecutters and higher durometer soft anvils.

- CF: cutting side in middle, ground one side
- SF: cutting edge on side
- SFS: cutting edge on side, ground on short bevel
